



# Environmentally Responsible Measures

## • Human Resources

- Involves volunteers for the realization of the event;
- The venue of the event is accessible to people with reduced mobility;
- First aid services will be on site;
- Has a security policy.

## • Food and Management of Residual Materials

- A water fountain service is available on site to minimize the use of plastic bottles;
- Reduction of residual materials by using compostable plates and glasses;
- The venue has recycling and compost bins;
- Reduced food waste by increasing the number of grocery store visits during the event for small orders;
- Promotes healthy eating habits by offering healthy products and menus and the vegetarian option will be offered.

### • • Environmental Awareness and Education

- Communicate and promote the eco-responsible measures put in place for the event;
- Train volunteers to promote these eco-responsible measures during the event.

## • Transportation, Travel and Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Emissions

- The event venue and hotel are within walking distance (5 minutes) and close to public transportation to reduce GHGs;
- We will prioritize local purchases for food and materials needed to hold the event to minimize GHGs;
- We encourage the participation of local artisans;
- For the transportation of officials from the airport to the hotel, we will, whenever possible, ensure their transport by our volunteers.

#### • Communications

- We will communicate event-related information to the general public by means of our website and social media, thus reducing printing on paper;
- We will communicate with participants and with dance schools only via email, thus reducing printing on paper;
- We will use a specific type of display on the event site, helping recuperation and reuse in the medium and long term;
- The scoring system for competitions will be electronic;
- The event program will be available online and can be downloaded. Anyone who would like a printed program will have to request it and pay the fees.
